The ministry was founded in 1984 by David M. Best, Michael R. Estep, and Cecil R. Paul (deceased). Towel & Basin was incorporated in 1992 as a Not for Profit Corporation in the State of Tennessee and is tax exempt under the Federal Internal Revenue Code 501(c)(3).
